Accreditation

YCIS - Secondary is accredited by the New England Association for Schools and Colleges (NEASC) and the Council of International Schools (CIS). It is authorised by International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO) as an IB World School and as a Cambridge International Examinations (CIE) Centre.

Years 7 - 9

The curriculum of the Lower Secondary / Middle School follows the National Curriculum for England's learning objectives with some specialist adaptation. Students become equipped with solid organisational skills and increased self and environmental awareness. These important years fully prepare students both academically and socially for the increasing challenges of the Upper Secondary years to follow.

Years 10 - 11 International General Certificate of Secondary Education

In Years 10 - 11 students work towards achieving the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE). This qualification is the most popular international certificate worldwide for this age group and is administered by the Cambridge International Examinations (CIE).

Students are required to choose at least one subject from each of the five major subject areas: Languages; Humanities; Sciences; Mathematics; and Creative, Technical and Vocational. IGCSE students are recognised internationally for problem solving, investigative, independent and co-operative working skills.

Years 12 - 13 International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme

The International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme is a rigorous pre-university course of study designed to meet the needs of highly motivated secondary students between the ages of 16 and 19. The International Baccalaureate Organization's (IBO) reputation for assessment gives IB Diploma holders access to the world's leading universities and the skills required for future success.

Pre-IGCSE and Pre-IB Courses

The Pre-IGCSE (Year 9 entry) and Pre-IB Programme (Year 11 entry) are developed to support students to continue on to the full IGCSE and IB Diploma programmes. These are comprehensive and rigorous programmes providing a well-balanced and challenging education which aims at enhancing their knowledge base and developing various skills:

management, oral presentation, exam writing and independent learning skills. They also deepen English language and literacy skills.

YCIS University Guidance (UGCs) Counsellors help students to realise their full potential and explore the different options available to progress from school to future careers. The emphasis in Years

7-11 is on developing awareness of interests, careers, and post-secondary aspirations used to inform academic planning for career and university readiness. In Years 12-13, the focus is on the actual process of university exploration, selection, and application. YCIS graduates regularly receive multiple offers and across different continents. The Class of 2016 celebrated 90% of the graduates attained offers to the world's top 100 and/or top 20 UK universities. The list included (not limited to):
